
The Remaking of Pittsburgh: Class and Culture in an Industrializing City 1877-1919 (American Social History)

The book explores the impact immigration on the shaping of modern Pittsburgh and the emergence of mass culture within the community. In the midst of these processes of transformation, the giant steel corporations were continually reshaping the life of the city.
