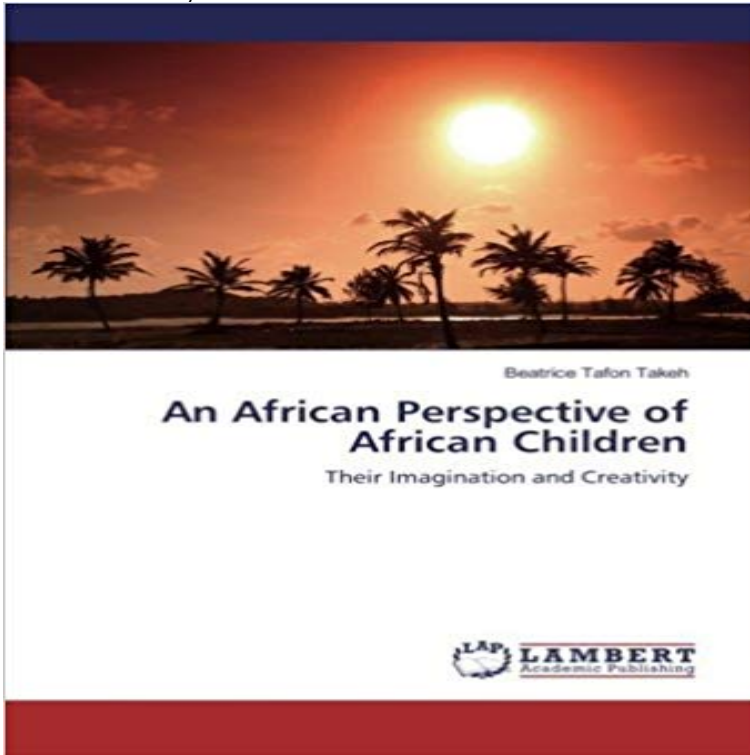


An African Perspective of African Children: Their Imagination and Creativity
