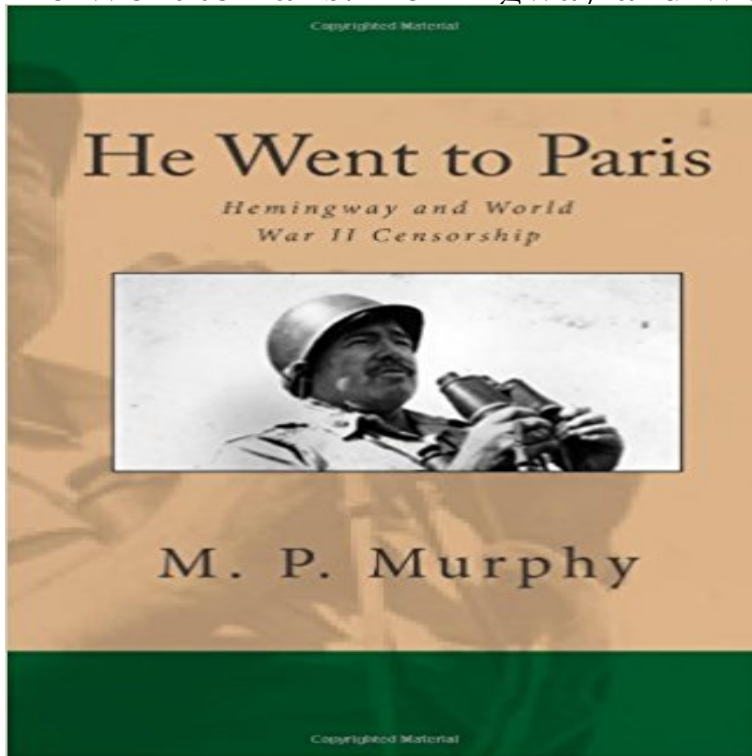


He Went to Paris: Hemingway and World War II Censorship
