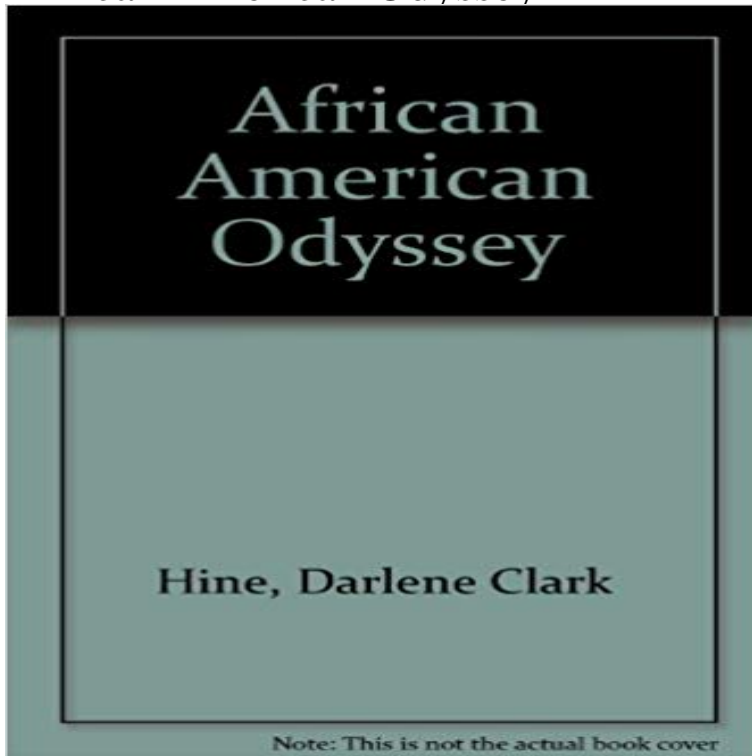


African American Odyssey
