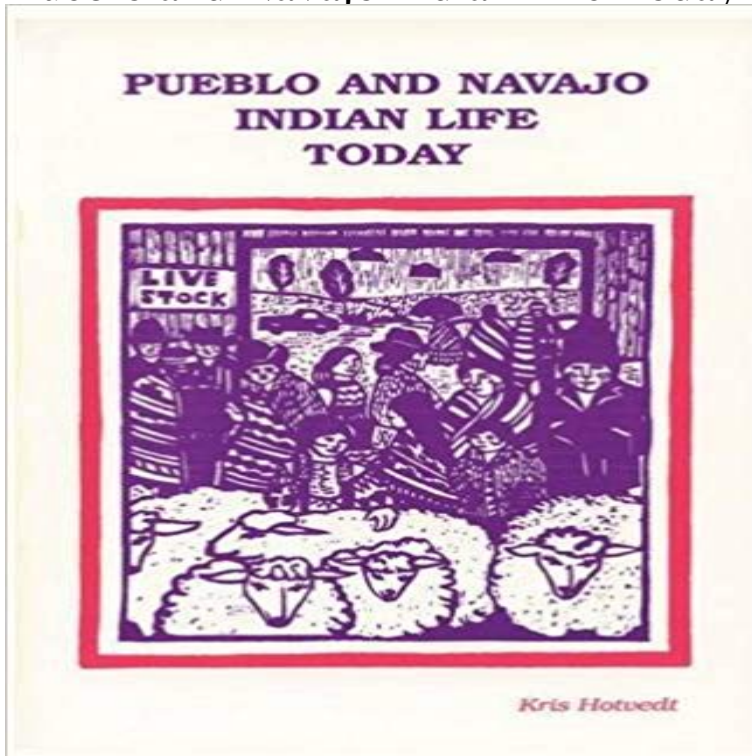


## Pueblo and Navajo Indian Life Today
